GETTING A MAINTAINING YOUR RABIES VACCINATION FOR YOUR PETS.

When do you get them?

At six months of age.

How often do you get it?

First shot is good for one year. Ever shot after is good for three years.

Where do you get them?

At any Veterinarian clinic.

Why get them?

Rabies is fatal to most animals if they come in contact with the virus.

Which animals get rabies?

Most cases occur in wildlife but in the recent years cats have become more common.



Spaying and neutering your pets.

- Fixing your pets can help in behavior and health problems
- Cuts down on over population.
- Spaying and neutering can be done as soon as 16 weeks in some vets offices.
- There are spay and neuter assistance programs offered locally.
- Fixed animals have fewer tendencies to roam.
- No unwanted litters.
- Cats can breed as many as 3 times a year and have an average of 4 kittens per a litter.
- Dogs can breed two times a year and have 6-10 puppies per a litter.
- For more information about spay/ neuter consult with your veterinarian.

Renewing your pets yearly tax tags.

When do you get them?

On or before September 30 after six months of age.

Where do you get them?

Harrison County courthouse assessor's office 304.624.8510.

How Often Do you get them?

Tax licensing is to be renewed yearly

How Much does it Cost?

\$6.00 per a tag.

Why Get them?

If your dog is lost you have a better chance of it being returned to you.
