## Cover Letter

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The Sunny Croft Country Club Annual First Responder Student Scholarship is awarded to a child of a first responder who is graduating from a Harrison County high school and who will attend a college, university, technical, or trade school in West Virginia. For this first year, two \$500 scholarships will be awarded.

The committee's intent is to recognize outstanding student potential, in consideration of a variety of aspects. These include, but are not limited to, academics, leadership, creativity, and personal development. In evaluating academics, the committee takes into consideration the degree of difficulty in the student's class load. The committee is interested in identifying students who are well rounded and exhibit exceptional qualities and potential to become leaders in all career fields. The committee will also consider economic need. All information submitted will be held in the strictest of confidence. Scholarship will be made to the intended school in student's name.

### **Eligibility Requirements**

1. A graduating senior of a Harrison County high school.
2. A child of a Harrison County First Responder.
3. Applicant must identify school or institution which they will attend after graduation.
4. Include letter of acceptance or application from intended institution of higher learning or trade school.
4. Submit applications on or before May 23, 2014.

### **APPLICATIONS FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP MUST INCLUDE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING MATERIAL. INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**

1. Completed student application. The only information available to the selection committee is that which the student provides. (Therefore, it is imperative that the entire application be completed. **DO NOT STAPLE.** Please use a paper clip to hold pages together.)
2. An up-to-date transcript of high school grades, including SAT or ACT scores.
3. Two letters of recommendation addressing character, scholarship and potential of applicant — one from a core teacher, art, or technical teacher (not a counselor or principal) in the school which the applicant currently attends and the other from a person not related to the applicant. (Examples: religious leader, community leader, volunteer organization, etc.)
4. Attach this letter to the application with student signature at the bottom.
