MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND TO INCLUDE
WATER PARK OPENING AND SUMMER KICK-OFF CONCERT

CLARKSBURG (May 14, 2014) – The City Parks of Clarksburg SPLASH ZONE will open for its second season on Saturday, May 24th City Parks Officials recently announced. SPLASH ZONE hours of operation are 12:00pm to 7:00pm Sunday through Saturday. Opening day for the water park will follow the Clarksburg Amphitheater’s summer kick off concert on May 23rd featuring country stars Josh Thompson, Frankie Ballard and Eric Paslay.

John Cooper, Superintendent of Parks, said, “Memorial Day weekend is going to be a lot of fun this year. We’ve got a great weekend of entertainment and recreation lined up for the community and we’re very much looking forward to it.”

The family oriented SPLASH ZONE water park includes a 25-meter competition pool, lazy river, 8 water slides including 2 tower water slides, beach-entry pool and lagoon, padded children area and plenty of fun and exciting tipping buckets, sprinklers, funbrellas and other surprises designed to keep you cool this summer.

“We’ve added a few exciting items to the facility this year,” Cooper added. “We’ve added Pete the Pelican Spray, Carly the Clownfish Slide and a large floating crab to join the widely-popular 9’ floating alligator.”

The admission rates have remained consistent from last year’s rates at \$9 for adults, \$7 for children and senior citizens, and \$5 for anyone after 4pm. The price of admission does include all-day use of the water slides.

Frequent SPLASH ZONE visitors may also be interested in the newly added season pass. These passes give guests unlimited admission for the season and are available for purchase at the Park Office located in Nutter Fort, as well as at the water park. Guests can also purchase fun passes, which act as a gift card towards water park admission, the mini-golf course, and water park concession stands. This pass is great for children as they can leave actual cash at home. It also gives discounted admission rates to the water park as well as to the mini golf course.

“Last summer our attendance records previously held by the city municipal pool were shattered over and over. I think the big success so far shows just how eager the community and surrounding areas were for better and more modern recreation options. We’re very proud of this addition to the city, along with the entertainment offerings that the Clarksburg Amphitheater has allowed us to deliver. This is going to be another fantastic summer!”
